Telecommunications Regulation Circular TRC-22 December 2, 1974

Implementation of Radio Standards Specification 214.

Radio Standards specification 214, Issue 1, entitled "Low-Power Wireless Microphones and Telemetering Devices For One-Way Communications, Operating in the FM Broadcast Band 88 - 108 MHz" has been released in final form with an effective date of October 31, 1974.

Equipments type-approved under this specification will be exempt from licensing in accordance with the General Radio Regulations Part II, Section 6, Subsection (1), Paragraph (k), and will be included in Part A-28 of the Radio Equipment List.

Wireless microphones and telemetering equipment, operating in the 88 to 108 MHz band and currently listed in Part C of the Radio Equipment List as technically acceptable, will be deleted from the list. In order to continue the use of such equipment, it will be necessary that this equipment be type-approved in accordance with Radio Standards Specification 214 and be listed in the appropriate part of the Radio Equipment List.

Equipment will not be type-approved automatically from the technical data on file. Applications for type-approval must be supported by complete documentation required for type-approval purposes. If further testing is not required, a copy of the original and any subsequent test data must accompany the application for type-approval.

Equipments currently listed in Part C of the Radio Equipment List will be deleted on January 1, 1975.
